

PROJECT UPDATE

Thank you for your interest in the Central Avenue Streetscape and Bridge Project!

We are pleased to provide this project update as part of our commitment to keeping the public informed throughout construction.*

Bridge construction and work along Central Avenue from the bridge to the southern half of the Aliceanna Street intersection began in January. Current lane closures include:

- Central Avenue between Lancaster Street and Aliceanna Street
- Lancaster Street between S. Exeter Street and S. Eden Street

Additionally, the Promenade between S. Exeter Street and S. Eden Street is closed to pedestrian and bicycle traffic.

Though some of the streets are closed, please note that **all of the businesses in the area remain open and accessible**. Some even offer valet parking so be sure to continue patronizing your favorite places, or try something new in the area!

The following activities are anticipated to begin within the next few weeks.


Upcoming Activities:

Beginning the Week of May 1, 2017:

On May 8, 2017:

Aliceanna St. between Central Ave. and Eden St. will be open to westbound traffic only. The road will be closed to eastbound traffic through summer 2018. (As referenced in our December 29, 2016 Traffic Advisory. See map below.)



Beginning the Week of May 8, 2017:


■ Roadway milling of Central Avenue
