


Central Avenue Streetscape & Harbor Point Connector Bridge Project



Maintenance of Traffic During Construction



January 2017 – Spring 2018

- Central Avenue from Aliceanna Street to Lancaster Street will be closed.
- Lancaster Street Promenade from S. Eden Street to S. Exeter Street will be closed.

Spring 2017 – Summer 2018

- Eastbound Aliceanna Street from S. Eden Street to S. Exeter Street will be closed. One westbound lane will remain open to traffic.

Spring 2017 – Spring 2020

- Central Avenue from Aliceanna Street to E. Baltimore Street will experience intermittent lane closures.

The sidewalk on the north side of Lancaster Street between S. Exeter Street and Central Avenue will remain open during construction.

BUSINESSES WILL REMAIN OPEN DURING CONSTRUCTION



Central Avenue Streetscape & Harbor Point Connector Bridge Project

WHERE: Baltimore City along Central Avenue from E. Baltimore Street to Lancaster Street.

WHAT: Streetscape rehabilitation that includes: new storm drains and traffic signals; improved roadway lighting; electrical duct-bank replacement; beautification; and bike, pedestrian and safety improvements.

A new bridge will be constructed between Lancaster Street and Harbor Point that will connect Central Avenue to Harbor Point's 27-acre mixed-use development.

WHY: Upon full development, Harbor Point is expected to encompass 3 million square feet of residential and commercial buildings as well as significant open space. The bridge will provide a much-needed connection to the development site from Central Avenue, and streetscape improvements will help accommodate increased traffic expected as a result of commercial and residential growth.

Benefits include improved safety, increased roadway capacity, improved mobility and aesthetic appeal.

WHEN:

Early 2017:	Construction of Harbor Point Connector Bridge Begins <i>(Lancaster Street to Dock Street)</i>
Spring 2017:	Construction of streetscape begins <i>(Aliceanna Street to E. Baltimore Street)</i>
Summer 2018:	Harbor Point Connector Bridge open to traffic
Spring 2020:	Project Completion

COST: Total Project: \$46.7 million
